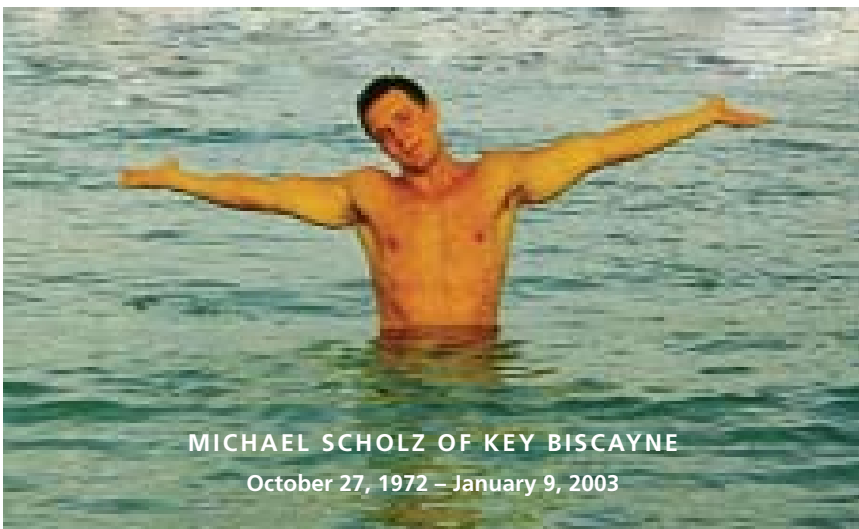

STEPS TO ENVIRONMENTAL CITIZENSHIP

Observe-Reflect-Recreate

Michael's Magic Campers donned their life vest and sea shoes to wade in the seagrass meadows of Biscayne Bay. Under the instruction of the camp naturalists, campers swept their nets through the underwater flowering plants so they could observe and learn about the fragile community of juvenile fish and marine life that thrive in Florida's seagrass, which is a principal contributor to the marine food web.

After the hands-on observation, campers wrote about one sea creature that they enjoyed learning about. They presented their written observations of seahorses, blowfish, manatees, or hatchling sea turtles to the group. The culmination of their observations was recreated in a beautiful aquatic painting created under the instruction of the camp art instructor.

Campers were engaged in environmental science, writing, public speaking and art. In this process of observing, reflecting and recreating, their environmental awareness was sparked.
